2018 Miss Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant Contestant Agreement Pageant Copy

As a contestant in the Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant, I agree to abide by the following:

- 1. Contestants must be 17 years old, but no older than 20 years old as of July 1 of the current year.
- 2. Contestants must be female, legal residents of Lincoln County, or attend school in Lincoln County at the time of the contest.
- 3. Contestants will be judged in the following categories: personal interview, speech or talent, resume and evening gown.
- 4. Contestants must have a speech on an agriculturally related topic or a talent for judging. Time limit is 3 (three) minutes.

Contestants must designate on their entry form if they are presenting a speech or a talent. All speeches will be judged in one category, and all talents will be judged in one category. Talent entries may have ONE musical accompanist, and speech entries may have NO assistance. Talent and speech entries must be the original work of the contestant and may NOT include any video tapes or video clips. Accompaniment CDs and written scripts of speeches are due at the practice on June 12th.

- 5. Contestants may participate in the contest two times within the age limits above.
- 5. Contestants should have no visible tattoo or body piercing.
- 6. Contestants need not be in any organization but must be sponsored either by an organization or a business firm. (If you need assistance finding a sponsor please contact us.)
- 7. Contestants may only have 1 (one) sponsor.
- 8. Contest is limited to the first 20 (twenty) contestants by postmark or date turned in. No late entries will be accepted. Deadline date is Friday, May 18, 2017. Entries must be postmarked no later than May 18 or turned in to the Extension Office BEFORE closing at 5 p.m. Do NOT leave in the afterhours mailbox.

 - b. June 5, 12, 19, 26, July 3 Pageant practice nights at Bonfils Auditorium 6 p.m.

 Attendance is at the discretion of the candidate. Practice nights are to in place to learn the opening number dance and rehearse speech and talents.
 - c. July 6 Dress rehearsal Bonfils Auditorium approximately 4 p.m.

- d. July 7 Miss Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant Bonfils Auditorium Candidates ready to interview by 2 p.m. Pageant begins at 6 p.m.
- e. July 8 Lincoln County Fair Parade approximately 4 p.m.

- 11. Practice sessions serve two purposes: 1. To help prepare for a public pageant and to help candidates do their best, and 2. To prepare a pageant suitable for public viewing, it is beneficial for candidates to be present to learn the evening gown modeling pattern, group numbers, and simply to practice the pageant events.
- 12. A \$125 entry fee to be paid by the sponsor is to accompany the entry forms with checks made payable to the Lincoln County Fair Board. Two pictures, either 3x5, 4x5 or 4x6, are to accompany the entry forms. These photos are to be vertical headshots only and must be an <u>original</u> photograph of the same pose no computer generated pictures. These pictures will be used to judge the Miss Photogenic Contest and for publication in the *Lincoln County Journal*. Once the pictures have been submitted, no substitutions will be allowed.
- 13. All contestants are expected to attend the Lincoln County Fair and to wear their sponsor's sash while in attendance at the fair.
- 14. Six (6) copies of contestant's resume and information sheets are due at the first Tuesday practice in June. Information on these forms will be given at the candidate information meeting.
