Rules and Regulations/Contest Information:

1. Contestant must be a resident of Lincoln County and have reached the ages of 4 or 5 years old by January 1st of 2018.
2. Pageant is limited to the **first 10 contestants** of each gender which turn in correct paperwork and entry fee by **June 22nd, 2018**.
3. Each contestant must attend the Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant which will include the Little Mister and Little Miss Pageant within it. (You may leave after the pageant unless you are crowned either Little Mr. or Little Miss.
4. Parents or chaperones will not be allowed on stage at any point during the pageant.
5. There will be a short one-on-one question with the emcee and each contestant will speak on stage.
 - a. Questions are provided on the accompanying application for the parents to practice with their child/children.
6. Each contestant should dress with the theme of "country". No formal wear (Suits, formal dresses) should be worn. Age appropriate clothing must be worn.
7. A \$15 entry fee is required per contestant, no refunds will be available.
8. The entry fee of \$15 must accompany each entry form.
9. Pageant will take place during an intermission of the Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant.
10. Contestants will be judged on creativity of answer to question, enthusiasm for the fair, and stage presence.
11. Contestants may run in the pageant no more than two years. Previous winners of the Little Mr. and Miss Pageant will be ineligible to run again.
12. The Judges decision is final.
13. Pageant directors and fair board have final say.

Responsibilities/important dates of attendance for Little Mister and Little Miss include:

- a. Attend Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant Rehearsal- July 6th at Bonfils Auditorium
- b. Attending Lincoln County Fair Queen Pageant/Little Mister and Miss Pageant- July 7th at Bonfils Auditorium
- c. Riding in fair parade- July 8th
- d. Attending Lincoln County Fair kids' games on Saturday morning- July 14th

One of the three questions below will be used as an on stage question at the pageant which will be asked to the contestant. Different questions will be asked to the different groups of the same gender. Please ask/practice these questions to your child in order to eliminate stage fright/silent answers. Additionally, please talk with your child about proper stage etiquette if they are not announced as winner.

1. What is your favorite kind of animal to visit in the Fair barns and why?
2. This year's Fair theme is Memories to Last a Lifetime, what is your favorite memory of the Fair?
3. What is your favorite part about the Fair?
