All speeches will be judged in one category, and all talents will be judged in one category. **Talent entries may have ONE musical accompanist, and speech entries may have NO assistance. Talent and speech entries must be the original work of the contestant and may NOT include any video tapes or video clips. Accompaniment CDs and written scripts of speeches are due at the practice on June 9.**
5. Contestants may participate in the contest two times within the age limits above.
6. Contestants should have no visible tattoo or body piercing.
7. Contestants need not be in any organization but must be sponsored either by an organization or a business firm. (If you need assistance finding a sponsor please contact us.)
8. Contestants may only have **1 (one) sponsor**.
