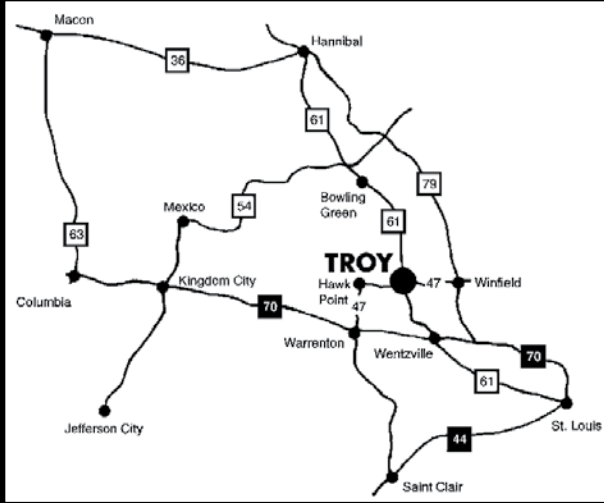


# HOW TO GET HERE



The Lincoln County Fair is held at Troy, Missouri.  
The Fairgrounds is located on Fairgrounds Road.

### From St. Louis Area:

Take Interstate 70 or 40/64 west towards Wentzville. When near Wentzville, merge onto Hwy 61 north to Troy. Exit at Hwy 47 (Troy). Go west (left) on Hwy 47. Go 1.5 miles to Fairgrounds Road stop light, take a right. The fairgrounds are approximately 1/4 mile on the right.

### From the West:

Take Interstate 70 to the Warrenton exit. Go north on Hwy 47 to Hawk Point. At the four-way stop in Hawk Point, turn right, continuing on Hwy 47. You may take Hwy H, a left turn off Hwy 47, to Fairgrounds Road and make a right turn. Or, stay on Hwy 47 to the first intersection past Hwy H. This will also be Fairground Road. Turn left and continue 1/4 mile to the fairgrounds.
